WAH-TUT-CA 2011 FAQs

Troop 159 will once again be laying claim to the Medicine Bow campsite at Camp Wah-Tut-Ca for the first week of the 2011 Camping Season. Here are some of the things you need to know:

- When: July 3rd – July 8th, 2011 – Make sure to adjust your vacation plans to enable your son to participate in this week
- Where: Camp Wah-Tut-Ca, Northwood, New Hampshire (about 80 miles from Westford center)
- Who: All scouts from the newest who have just “crossed over” from Webelos to the most grizzled Venture Scout
- How Much: \$ 320.00 if the fee is paid by May 19, 2011 or \$ 370.00 if paid by June 16, 2011
- What do the scouts need to do to attend:
 1. Complete an application and pay \$ 320.00 per Scout by May 19, 2011*
Or
Complete an application and pay \$ 370.00 per Scout by June 16, 2011
 2. Submit a completed medical history/evaluation completed by a physician after July 9, 2010 (the medical form that must be filled out is available from adult leaders or may be downloaded from the Troop 159 website under “Summer Camp”).
- Can the Scout go back for additional weeks? YES!!!
Camp Wah-Tut-Ca offers additional weeks of Provisional Camp each week from July 10 through August 5. The costs for the Provisional Camp is \$ 295 per week assuming that the Scout will also participate in the Troop 159 week of July 3-8.*
Camp Wah-Tut-Ca EXTREME is offered August 7-12 with 6 different options
 - Biospehere
 - Shooting Sports
 - Aquatics
 - Kajah! (Creative Arts)
 - Climbing
 - Eagle WeekAge/Scout Rank Minimums apply to some of these programs. The costs for WTC EXREME is \$ 305 per week.* Fees for these programs are based on the assumption that the Scout will also participate in the Troop 159 week of July 3-8
- Can Adults go to camp? YES!!!
Parents are encouraged to go to camp as part of the ‘Godfather Patrol’, helping the Troop by providing an adult presence and supporting rank advancement. Adults wishing to go **must** be registered with the Troop as Council Members or Assistant Scoutmasters, submit a completed current medical form, and coordinate their schedule with Rob O’Neal or Mike Mulligan. For supporting Troop 159’s activities, a Scout’s parent does not pay a fee to attend camp (a nominal charge for meals will be charged for meals if the parent is staying for less than 3 nights)
