All Participant Requirements

- Must be a registered Scout or registered adult (Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster, Committee Member) – Need to reregister in the Spring
- Passed the BSA 1st Class Swim test – Offered at Camp Wah-tut-ca
- 2 copies of SeaBase Health and Medical Record filled out and signed by your doctor after August 4, 2009 (Different than the official BSA Medical form which will need to be filled out for camp this year) – Includes copies of both sides of your health insurance card
- Health Insurance Card
- Know and use the Scout Oath and Law as guides for appropriate behavior on SeaBase

Adult Participant Requirements

All of the following courses can be taken online. They do require your BSA ID number which is on your BSA card number if you have never registered inline
